As Day is a latex free environment, we ask that you will be aware of this when purchasing pencils which your children will need for school. We will provide all students with an Assignment Book, so please do not purchase one.

The following is a list of supplies that the sixth grade teams would like each child to purchase:

- 4 Separate 1 inch flexible 3 ring binders (no trappers)
- 3 8 pack dividers
- 2 packs of loose leaf graph paper
- 2 packs of loose leaf – 3 hole punched white lined paper
- highlighters, latex free pencils and colored pencils
- red pens
- 2 different colored pocket folders with fasteners
- Mead composition notebook

We have found that having the following supplies **at home in a special area** have helped students complete homework assignments and projects at various times throughout the year:

Calculator, scissors, colored pencils, tape, stapler, thick and thin markers, glue or glue stick, ruler, measuring tape at home while completing homework.
